World Congress 2021, Johannesburg, South Africa

Early Registration has passed. Registration cost is now \$600.00 until July 31, 2021. Then the cost is \$650.00 up until World Congress begins.

The Senate Hotel is the DaVinci Hotel not the Intercontinental. This hotel is 400 meters from the congress meeting venue. DaVinci Hotel is located in the Nelson Mandela Square. The Main Hotel is the Sandton Hotel which is 350 meters from the Congress Venue.

South Africa is still requiring face coverings at all activities; also a current curfew is in effect from 12:00 A.M. until 4:00 A.M. Quarantine is not required at this time, nor is social distancing. A negative Covid-19 test is required 72 hours before departure from the first embarkation point.

History of the Day:

1862 - President Abraham Lincoln signed an act establishing the Department of Agriculture.

1918 - U.S. airmail began service between Washington, D.C., Philadelphia and New York.

1942 - President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed a measure creating the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps, whose members came to be known as WACs. Wartime gasoline rationing went into effect in 17 Eastern states, limiting sales to three gallons a week for non-essential vehicles.
